Extended Day Enrichment Activities Program

The Dore Academy Extended Day Enrichment Activities Program is open to all Dore Academy students in grades 1 – 12. **This handbook includes the activities included in Session II only.**

DATES:

Session II: Weeks of March 1—March 29, 2010

TIMES:

Activities will run 3:15 p.m. to 4:15 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.

PARTICIPATION:

To participate in this program, you must first complete an **Extended Day** Registration Form along with the **Extended Day Enrichment Activities** Registration Form (both registration forms are included in this handbook). If you have already registered with Extended Day, and want to participate in an Extended Day Enrichment Activity, you only need to complete an Extended Day Enrichment Activities registration form.

The Extended Day Enrichment Activities Program will operate on all normal school days, Monday through Friday. **The Extended Day Enrichment Activities Program will not be offered on student holidays or when school is in session only half-day. If the school is closed on a day of your scheduled activity, the session will extend a week.**

FEES:

The cost may vary depending on the activity being offered. Refer to the Extended Day Program Catalogue for pricing (included in this handbook). Activities are filled on a first-come, first-serve basis.

REFUNDS:

Dore and/or partner organizations reserve the right to alter or cancel classes due to inadequate enrollment. Families will be notified when classes are filled or cancelled. If an activity is cancelled, a refund will be returned.

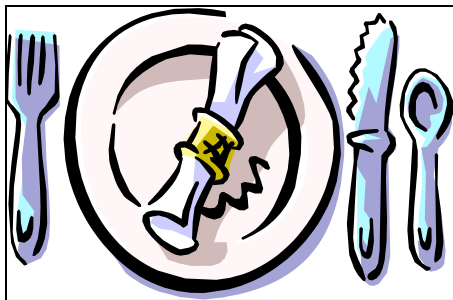
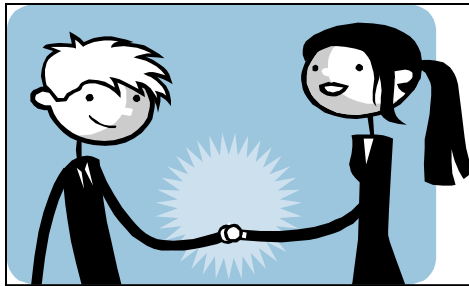

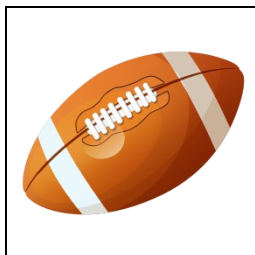
